There has been a slight increase in the number of lates this week. Please remember that we run a free Breakfast Club from 8.00am onwards where children can have breakfast and do activities. Children must be in Breakfast Club before 8.30am if they require a breakfast. Our doors open for children not attending Breakfast Club at 8.45am and the register is taken at 9.00am.

If your child arrives after 9.00 am they are to come into school through the main entrance (not their classroom door) with an adult to explain why they are late. We have to log a reason for lateness and we cannot accept reasons from children - it must be from the adult bringing them into school. If your child arrives after 9.30am then this is marked on the register as a 'U' mark. This will then affect your child's attendance as it is classed as an unauthorised absence.
