#### **English**

Improve your English skills and start working towards a nationally recognised qualification. The Functional Skills English courses will give you confidence in using your skills as well as the opportunity to gain a qualification. Tutors will work with you to design your own learning programme, which will include individual and group work. Classes are delivered in a safe, comfortable learning environment.



#### **Getting Started with English**

Our Getting Started course will give you a great introduction to studying English and will assess your starting point so your programme is tailored to suit your needs.

- Initial assessment of your existing skills
- Refresher sessions to prepare you for your course

This is a 5 session course and you will need to attend each week to achieve the course aims.

### On completion of the Getting Started with English Course you will work towards an English qualification and develop skills in

- Understanding written information, such as forms, newspapers and letters

- Spelling

#### **Maths**

#### **Computer Skills**

We believe that everyone should be able to engage in a digital world if they choose to, therefore all of our computer courses are free of charge.

We deliver a range of computer courses from absolute beginners to more advanced skills. Our friendly classes will take you step by step through a range of computer packages to make some of those everyday tasks much easier!



#### **Keyboarding for Beginners**

Learn the basics in a friendly, relaxed class. You will learn:

- How to turn the computer on and off safely
- How to use the mouse and keyboard
- How to use the internet to support your hobbies and interests
- Internet safety
- An introduction to Word Processing

This is an 11 week course you will complete an assessment at the end of your course. You will need to attend one 2.5 hour session per week to achieve the course aims.

#### **First Step Computers**

Once you have mastered the basics, our First Step course will introduce you to some more Microsoft packages. You will learn:

- How to create text documents and posters using Microsoft Word
- How to design greetings cards and professional looking documents using Microsoft Publisher
- How to create presentations using Microsoft Powerpoint
- How to set up and use an email account

This is an 11 week course you will complete an assessment at the end of your course. You will need to attend one 2.5 hour session per week to achieve the course aims.

#### **Next Step Computers**

Our Next Step course will explore each of the above topics in more detail and allow you to practice your skills. You will learn:

- How to use a file management system to create, move and delete folders
- More advanced Word Processing
- Formulas and functions in Microsoft Excel
- More advanced use of Microsoft Powerpoint

This is an 11 week course you will complete an assessment at the end of your course. You will need to attend one 2.5 hour session per week to achieve the course aims.

#### Level 1 IT

Our Level 1 IT course will build on the skills you've gained on our other IT courses and you will explore a range of IT topics in more detail. Topics include:

- File management
- Word Processing
- Spreadsheets
- E mail functions

This is a 15 week course and you will complete an assessment at the end of your course. You will need to attend one 2.5 hour session per week to achieve your course aims.



#### **IT Drop In**

Our IT Drop in runs weekly in both Kingsway and Acorn Learning Centres. It is designed to help those needing a little help with internet based job search and job applications, but provides an ideal opportunity for anyone wanting to practice their IT skills between sessions. There is no need to book, just drop in and a member of our friendly staff will be on hand to support you.

#### **Essential Digital Skills**

This course offers a qualification to improve ICT knowledge and understanding to help you in work or at home. You will learn how to use a variety of technology to focus your skills on the following:

- Using Devices and Handling Information
- Creating and editing

- Being Safe and Responsible Online
- Using Devices and Handling Information
- Creating and Editing documents & Digital Media



#### **Childcare**

Our Childcare programme will equip you with the skills and experience you will need to undertake a career in the childcare sector. Our courses are relaxed and informal and you will be supported by skilled and experienced teaching staff throughout.

In addition to the course fee, there is an additional one-off charge of £30 which covers registration with CACHE, the examination awarding body.



#### L1 Certificate in Caring for Children

An introductory course starting in January for learners with little or no experience of childcare, who are thinking of a career in Primary, Secondary or a Special School setting. This L1 qualification is a good **introduction** to childcare and will give a good grounding for those wishing to undertake the L2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools. Some of the topics covered include:

- Understanding Play for Early Learning
- Sharing Learning Experiences with Children
- Respecting and Valuing Children
- Supporting Healthy Choices
- Communicating with Children

This is an 22 week course and you will need to attend one 5 hour session per week to achieve the course aims.

The L1 course fee of £120 is payable at enrolment or in 2 instalments of £60 per term, payable before the first day of each term.

#### L2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning

A full year course, starting in September, for learners with little or no experience of childcare, who would like to work in a Primary, Secondary or Special School setting. This recognised L2 qualification is the industry standard to work in a supervised role. This course is suitable for learners wanting to work as a Teaching Assistant, Learning Support Assistant or Special Educational Needs Assistant. Some of the topics covered include:

- Child Development
- Health & Safety / Safeguarding
- Supporting positive behaviour
- Supporting learning activities
- Communication Skills

You must be able to complete a **180 hour work placement** at a school or nursery throughout the year to gain your industry experience.

This is **a full year course** and you will need to attend one 5 hour session per week to achieve the course aims.

The L2 **course fee of £180** is payable at enrolment or in 3 instalments of £60 payable before the first day of each term.

Learners enrolling on the L2 course will be subject to an enhanced **Disclosure** and **Barring Service check**. The cost for this is currently £44.

#### **Added Value:**

Although not a qualification requirement, all childcare learners are offered the opportunity to gain a **L3 First Aid qualification** at a subsidised rate to enhance their employability skills.

A series of 3 short courses for beginners and intermediates to improve skills in a variety of art techniques. 3 courses are on offer:

#### **Drawing:**

- How to use a variety of drawing tools including a variety of pencils, charcoals, pens.
- How to draw in perspective, using effective composition

Each course is 2.5 weeks in length and you will need to attend one 2 hour session per week to achieve the course aims.

#### **Let's Get Crafty - Interior Design**

On this new FREE online course you will have the opportunity to learn and develop your craft skills. These crafts can be used to create wonderful pieces for the home from recycled items or give you the opportunity to explore setting up your own business selling these unique products. Other topics include producing wall art by recycling old magazines and card, creating flower pots from plastic bottles, making bowls using buttons and string, making stationery holders using old tin cans





#### **Skills for Employment**

The Adult Learning Team has a highly successful track record in supporting local people into employment. Our courses are planned and designed with local employers to enable adults develop the skills needed for employment. These short, part-time courses will give you a quick boost to help you get the job you want.



#### **Halton Employment Partnership Awards**

These courses are designed to help adults get into work as quickly as possible. They are planned with local employers to ensure you develop the skills needed for employment, relevant to local job opportunities. Courses are held in the following areas:

- Care
- Construction
- Contact Centre Operations
- Customer Service
- Traffic Management
- Highway Maintenance

- Retail
- Hospitality
- Environmental Services
- Warehousing and Storage
- Business Administration

Courses are generally 5 weeks long but can vary in length depending on the subject. You do need to attend regularly to achieve the course aims.

#### **Employability Workshops**

## Learner Guidance On Return To Class Based Learning

Dear Learner,

Following the recent Government announcement 22 February 2021, we are able to start welcoming a small number of classes back into Centre from 8th March 2021.

The safety of our learning community remains our top priority and we are following Government guidance to ensure that our learners and staff remain safe on their return.

A key part of the Government guidelines is the use of testing. **Those** learners returning to Centre are therefore asked to take a lateral flow (SMART) test before attending their lesson and on a weekly basis while on course. (Teaching staff will also undertake a weekly test.)

This is one of the ways that will help us keep everyone safe as it will identify people who may be carrying the virus without showing symptoms. Learners will be asked to show their result to their tutor on entry.

#### How to get a test:

- No booking required. Occasionally, at busy times, you may need to queue but staff are working very hard to ensure people get through the centre as quickly as possible, within 15 minutes in most cases.
- The test involves a swab from the nose and mouth, which is done by you. The results are usually available from 30 minutes to two hours later.

- Please observe social distancing and wear face coverings when visiting the test centre.
- Please see site details and opening times below.

This is a temporary measure and we will keep you informed of further developments as home testing kits become available. If for any reason, you are unable to take a test prior to attending you will be asked to take a temperature check on entry, using a non-contact forehead thermometer. Learners with a high temperature/fever (37.8C or greater) will not be able to attend their class.

**IMPORTANT:** If you or a member of your household are displaying any flu-like symptoms or symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) or have tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) in the last 10 days, please do not attend the Centre. If you become unwell after attending our Centre please contact us immediately to let us know by emailing Adult.Learning@halton. gov.uk and include 'COVID-19 ABSENCE' in the subject field.

There are several other measures in place to ensure your safety. Please take a moment to read the following important information before you visit:

#### Class start/end times

You may find that your class starts or ends at a slightly different time than it usually would. This is to ensure that we are managing the number of people entering/leaving the building so that social distancing can be maintained at all times.

#### **Entering the Centre**

Please arrive no more than 5 minutes early for your class to avoid queues and follow the social distancing rules while you are waiting. If you are attending Acorn, Reception staff will sign you in and out of the building. If you are attending Kingsway, your tutor will sign you in. You will be asked to show negative test result if you have one, or take a temperature check on entry.

Please note: To support the NHS Test and Trace service, Halton Adult Learning will record all visitors to the Centre's telephone number, this will enable easier contact should a confirmed case of coronavirus (COVID-19) be identified. This will be a temporary record and kept securely for 21 days, before being destroyed.

#### **Social Distancing**

We have reduced numbers of learners in Centre to ensure that social distancing is in place in all of our classrooms. Our Centre also has floor markings in place to support 2 metre social distancing guidelines. To aid ventilation in classrooms and across the Centre windows and doors will need to remain open, whilst still adhering to fire regulations. You may want to bring appropriate clothing.

#### **Face Coverings**

Face coverings/masks should be worn when in Centre unless you are exempt. Face coverings need to fit securely around the side of the face, therefore visors are not suitable. Wearing a face covering helps reduce the spread of coronavirus droplets, helping to protect others. Where a learner is exempt it is essential that 2m social distancing is in place at all times.

#### Hygiene

All visitors must sanitize their hands when they come into the building and regularly during their visit. Additional hand sanitizer stations are placed at key areas in the Centre. The Centre has been deep cleaned and each room will be sanitized at the end of each class and again at the end of each day – this includes fabric chairs, which will be treated with Anti-bacterial fabric spray.

#### What do I do if I feel unwell?

If you feel that you are unable to come to your class due to illness please contact the Centre on 0151 511 7788 before 9.30am, where possible. Please DO NOT attend Centre if you have any Coronavirus symptoms.
